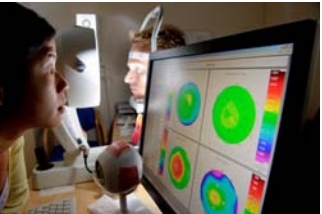
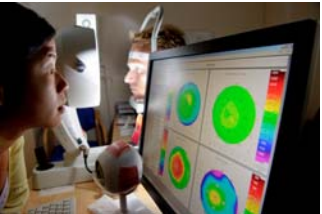

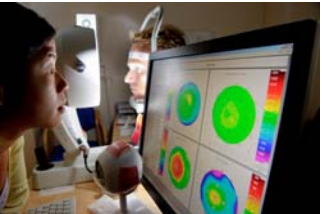




# Why are we going for FT?

- Opportunity to innovate



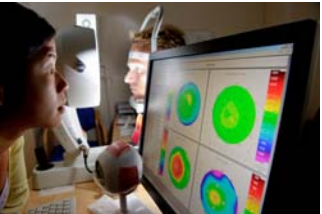

- Extending the range of services available in the community



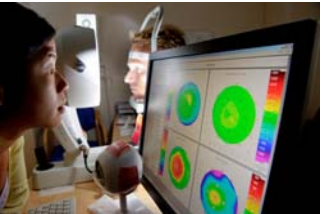
### Responsive acute services:

- Working with (other) agencies to provide care closer to home

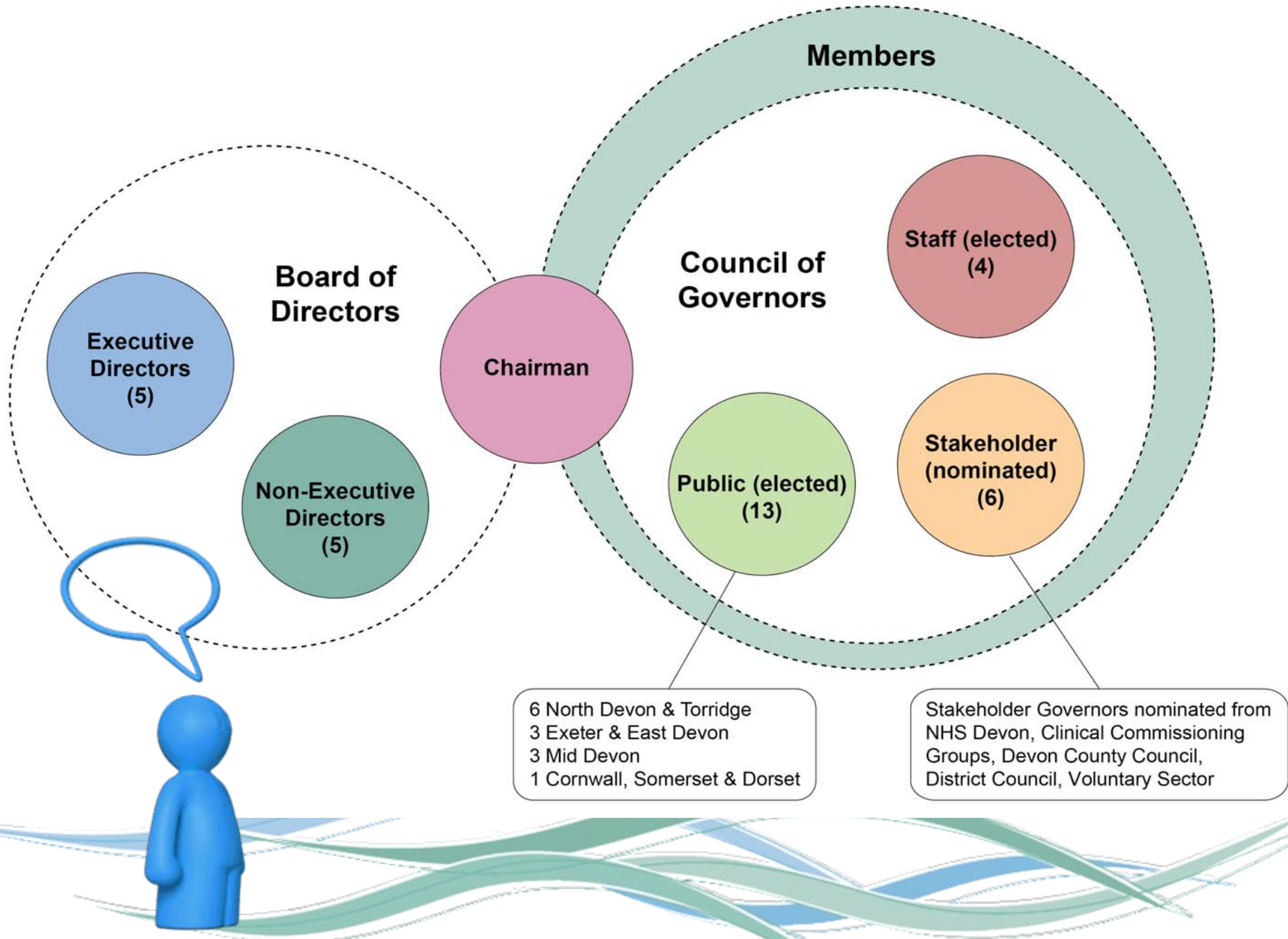


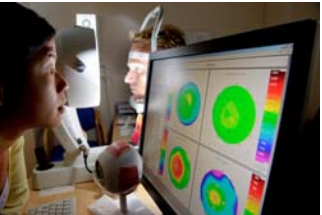

# Foundation Trust Governance Structure

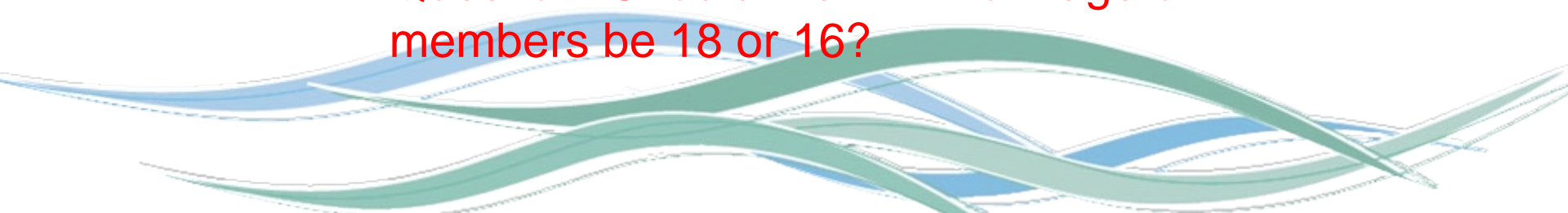
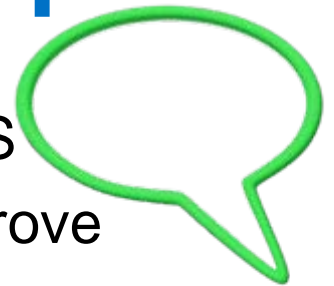


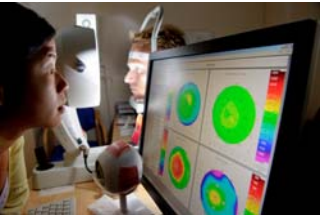


# Role of the membership

**Question: Should the minimum age of members be 18 or 16?**





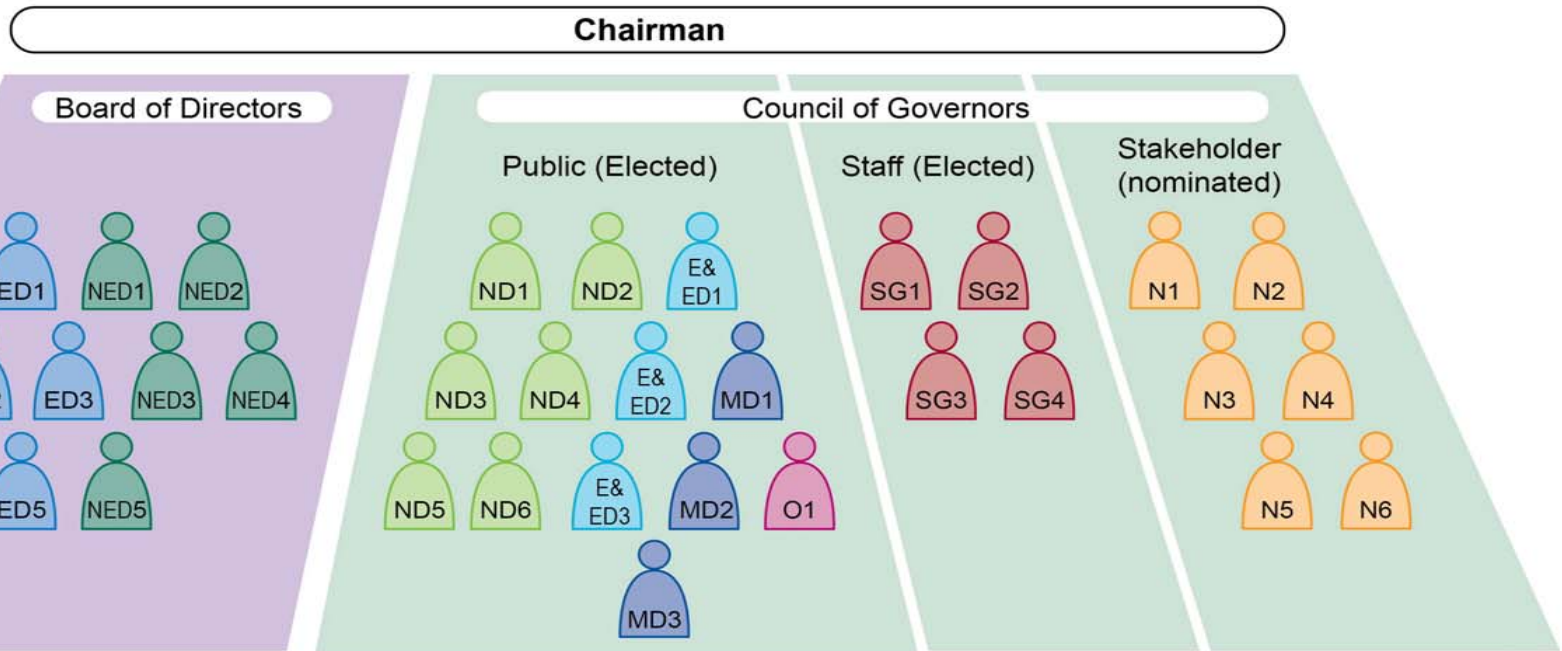
# Role of the Governors

The majority of the Council is elected. The Governors:

- Represent the interests of the communities served
- Develop networks for engaging the community
- Communicate information about the Trust
- Appoint the Non-Executives, including Chair
- Approve the appointment of the Chief Executive and Executive Directors
- Appoint the external auditors
- Receive the annual report and accounts

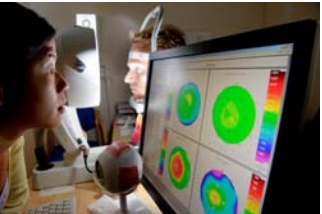
